<b>Acer palmatum</b>	<b>Japanese maples grafted by Cav</b>	<b>Plant Nursery - Hardy, handle cold, coloured varieties do best in full sun. Shelter from wind. \$200/5</b>	<b>\$45</b>
	Asahi Zuru	Pink with white that gets more intense over the seasons, turns red/orange in Autumn. 2.5m	
	Aureum - Golden Yellow Maple	Soft yellow leaves, mature to orange, then are red in Autumn, upright and slow growing. 2.5m	
	Green Cascade	Vibrant green weeping form with heavy & deeply dissected foliage, yellow/orange in Autumn. 2m	
	Japanese Sunrise	Spring leaves of yellow/green, turn fully green in Summer, golden/yellow in Autumn with red stems. 4m.	
	Viridis	Soft fresh green foliage, shades of golden/orange in Autumn, cascading branches, dome shaped tree. 1.5m	
<b>Acer palmatum (no grafts)</b>	Atropurpureum	Rich crimson colour that bronzes more in Summer and turns scarlet in Autumn, good town shade tree. 4m	<b>\$25</b>
<b>Aesculus x carnea</b>	Red Horse Chestnut	Outstanding ornamental with large erect panicles of deep scarlet flowers, seeds contain saponin. 12m	<b>\$20</b>
<b>Albizia julibrissin</b>	Rosea	Silky pink and fragrant flowers, ferny leaves with wide spreading branches, great shade tree. 5m	<b>\$10</b>
<b>Alnus</b>	<b>Alders</b>	<b>Fast growing shelter trees that do well in wetter soils, nitrogen enriching plants.</b>	
<b>cordata</b>	Italian Alder	Fast growing, deep rooted, nitrogen fixing tree, moderately drought tolerance, trims well. 20m	<b>\$20</b>
<b>glutinosa</b>	Black Alder	Grows best in most/wet soils, deep rooted, nitrogen fixing, tolerates salt wind, good firewood. 15m	<b>\$20</b>
<b>Betula</b>	<b>Birch</b>	<b>Deciduous hardwood trees, Birch bark varies in colour and mottling, beautiful driveway trees.</b>	<b>\$20</b>
<b>papyrifera</b>	Paper Birch	Mauve/Violet flower racemes appear with the leaves, lovely scent, the bark is white and rolls up like scrolls. 8m	
<b>pendula</b>	Silver Birch	Straight trunk with silvery white bark, golden foliage in Autumn, tolerant of poor soils, fast growing. 15m	
<b>Cornus</b>	<b>Dogwood</b>	<b>Well loved for their hardiness, graceful habit and flowers, perfect specimen trees, shelter from winds</b>	
<b>florida/nuttallii</b>	Eddies White Wonder	Upright, slightly weeping tree, ideal in small spaces, large creamy white flowers, fiery shades in Autumn. 4m	<b>\$60</b>
<b>Edgeworthia grandiflora</b>	Yellow Daphne - Paper Bush	Special & unique Chinese plant that adds yellow scented winter flower clusters, upright, grey leaves.. 1.5m	<b>\$45</b>
<b>Fagus</b>	Beech	<b>Hardy, deciduous trees that make excellent paddock shade plants, stout trunks and wind hardy.</b>	
<b>sylvatica</b>	European Beech	Tall, spreading green tree, golden autumn colours, when brown they hold over winter, wind hardy. 25m.	<b>\$20</b>
<b>Gleditsia</b>		<b>Feature or shade tree in the garden, dainty fern like leaves with a weeping form, fast growing.</b>	
<b>triacanthos</b>	Emerald Cascade	Fresh green foliage in spring, turning shades of gold in autumn, cascading foliage. 3m.	<b>\$45</b>
<b>Liquidambar styraciflua</b>	America Sweet Gum	Conical shaped tree, becomes rounded by wind, Autumn colours of yellow, orange, red & purple. 8m	<b>\$25</b>
<b>Lirodendron tulipifera</b>	Tulip Tree	Tall, fast growing tree, yellow/green flowers following by bright green leaves that are yellow in Autumn. 30m	<b>\$20</b>

	Sunsation	Best yellow hybrid, lemon/chartreuse and a hint of reddish purple on outer tepals, upright growth. 5m	
<b>stellata</b>	Star Magnolia King Rose	Compact rounded, multi branched bush, soft, pose pink buds open to white with pale pink. 3m	
<b>stellata</b>	Star Magnolia Waterlily	Excellent white form from Japan with many tepals, may open pink some seasons, long flowering. 3m	
<b>Nyssa sylvatica</b>	Black Tupelo	Grows well in a swamp, slow growing, has brilliant, deep, dark red to orange autumn foliage. 7m.	<b>\$15</b>

	Frosty Morn	Pure white double blooms, en masse, frost hardy shrub, trim after flowering to keep bushy. 1.5m	<b>\$45</b>

<b>Quercus</b>	Oaks	<b>Hardwood trees with many leaf shapes &amp; different Autumnal colours, acorn bearers, very hardy.</b>	
<b>cerris</b>	Turkey Oak	Broad open form, vigorous when established, very hardy, brown leaves in Autumn. 35m	<b>\$15</b>
<b>coccinea</b>	Scarlet Oak	Broad conical tree with drooping branches & dark red bark, brilliant scarlet leaves in Autumn. 20m	
<b>falcata</b>	Southern Red Oak	Large tree with a long, straight trunk and upward reaching branches, rounded crown, red Autumn. 30m	<b>\$15</b>
<b>muehlenbergii</b>	Chinkapin Oak	Medium sized white oak, airy growth structure, great shade tree, yellow/brown winter foliage. 20m	<b>\$15</b>
<b>palustris</b>	Pin Oak	Large, handsome, broad spreading tree with central leader, Autumn colour flaming orange-red. 20m	<b>\$30</b>
<b>robur</b>	English Oak	Classic oak, broad in growth with deeply fissured bark, Autumn colour of yellow, holds till winter. 20m	<b>\$25</b>
<b>rubra</b>	Red Oak	Vigorous, medium sized, broad spreading tree, large leaves that are red/brown in Autumn. 30m	
<b>Ribes</b>		<b>Related to eating currants, these plants are grown for their striking flowers, nice specimens.</b>	<b>\$8</b>
<b>aureum</b>	Yellow Flowering currant	Small bush with masses of yellow, spice scented spring flowers, nice splash of colour. 2.5m	
<b>odotarium</b>	Red Flowering currant	Small bush that has a mass of red scented spring flowers, nice pop of colour. 2.5m.	
<b>Tilia cordata</b>	Small Leaved Linden	Dense pyramidal shape with masses of pale yellow scented flowers, green leaves, yellow in Autumn. 8m	<b>\$20</b>
