<b>Abelia x Grandiflora</b>		Excellent hedging plant, glossy green foliage with fragrant white flowers, vigorous, easy to trim. 3m	\$7
<b>Alnus</b>	Alders	<b>Fast growing shelter trees that do well in wetter soils, nitrogen enriching plants.</b>	\$15
<b>cordata</b>	Italian Alder	Fast growing, deep rooted, nitrogen fixing tree, moderately drought tolerance, trims well. 20m	
<b>glutinosa</b>	Black Alder	Grows best in moist/wet soils, deep rooted, nitrogen fixing, tolerates salt wind, good firewood. 15m	
<b>Buxus</b>		<b>Hardy hedges, small leaves, tight growth, easily trimmed, used in topiary and as classic hedges.</b>	\$7
<b>sempervirens</b>	English Box	Extremely hardy slow growing ideal for low hedges, keep trimmed. Can topiary. 2m.	
<b>sempervirens variegata</b>	Variagated English Box	Dark green leaves are margined gold to yellow, evergreen, hardy. 1.5m.	
<b>Camellia</b>		<b>Smart shiny green foliaged shrubs, showy flowers autumn /spring.</b>	\$8
<b>japonica</b>	Mark Allen	Large, wine red semi double blooms with narrow petals, upright growth, makes a good hedge. 2.5m	
<b>sasanqua</b>	Early Pearly	Medium sized, double white with a hint of pink on the edges. Vigorous upright habit, nice hedge. 2m	
<b>Choisya ternata</b>	Mexican Orange Blossom	Hardy, fast-growing, white flowering shrub, distinctive fragrant stems. 2m.	\$7
<b>Coprosma</b>		<b>Evergreen plants, some have a spreading habit and others are divaricating. Very hardy.</b>	\$7
<b>acerosa</b>	Westport	Upright fine foliage, new shoots golden, billowing look and habit. 1m.	
	Galaxy	Taranaki origin, small round foliage of green/brown colour. Looks like floating leaves. 2m	
<b>grandifolia</b>	Kanono/Raurekau	Attractive yellow green foliage, mottle with dark green and purple, orange berries, revegetation. 5m	
<b>repens</b>	Taupata	Large coastal shrub with broad glossy, dark green leaves, red-orange fruit for birds, good hedge. 5m	
	Beatsons Gold	Compact rounded shrubs with small variegated green/gold leaves, trims easily, very hardy. 1.2m+	
	Cappuccino	Bronze/brown leaves, which lighten to a coffee colour in Winter, smaller leaves than most repens. 1.2m	
	Marble Queen	Cream foliage on outer margin, deep green in centre, hardy, does brilliantly coasta. 1.2m	
	Middlemore	Fantastic coprosma for screening/hedging, small round glossy leaves, tight growth, hardy. 1mx2m	
	Portwine	Bronze/red foliage, excellent for hedging, glossy leaves and tight growth, hardy. 1.5m	
<b>robusta</b>	Karamu	Fast growing shelter, deging and nursery plant, competes well with gorse, attracts birds. 5m+	
<b>rugosa</b>	Lobster	Divaricating pyramidal shrub, bronze/green foliage, pink/gold trunks, cool looking plant. 1.2cm.	
<b>Syn. C.</b>	Dark Spire	Pyramidal, dark glossy green narrow foliage, hardy specimen or row. 1.2m.	
<b>virescens</b>	Mingimingi/Mikimiki	Divaricating shrub, small foliage, cascading gold stems, very interesting growth. 3m.	
<b>Corokia</b>	Korokio	<b>Tough salt-wind hardy shrub, small flowers &amp; coloured berries, low maintenance hedging.</b>	\$7
	Bronze King	Deep bronze Winter foliage, green new growth. Fine leaves. 2.5m.	
<b>buddleioides</b>		Yellow flowers, red berries, green foliage, long thin leaves. 2m.	
<b>cotoneaster</b>		Silver new growth, green grey foliage, long, thin leaves. 3m.	
	Emerald & Jade	Compact, green foliage, silvery stems, fast dense tidy dwarf hedge. 1.2m.

	Sun Splash	Variegated lemon & pale green foliage in shade, darker in full sun. Lovely 2.5m.	
	Yellow Wonder	Yellow flowers, gold berries, green foliage, similar growth as Geenty's Green. 2.5m.	
<b>Corynocarpus laevigatus</b>	Karaka	Small tree, large glossy leaves, orange fruit that Kereru eat. 7m.	\$7
<b>Dacrycarpus dacrydioides</b>	Kahikatea	Native podocarp, tolerates high water table, grows well in stands in swampy areas. 65m+.	\$7
<b>Escallonia</b>		<b>Variety of shrubs that do very well as hedging, compact growth, fast, flowers for bees.</b>	\$7
	Apple Blossom	Mixed pink white flowers, quick growing, bushy quickly, smaller leaf. 3m.	
	Fields Scarlet	Darker pink red flowers, quick growing, easily trimmed, smaller leaf. 3m.	
	Snowbud	White flowers, quick growing, great hedge, medium leaf. 3m.	
<b>Euonymus</b>	Emerald Gem	Hardy compact shrub, glossy foliage, alternative to buxus small hedge or topiary. 50cm.	\$7
<b>Griselinia</b>	Kapuka Broadleaf	<b>Tough marginal / coastal wind hardy shrub, grows well coast to mountain.</b>	\$7
<b>littoralis</b>	Broadway Mint	Glossy, deep green leaves, quick to establish, little maintenance required, very hardy. 4m+	
<b>Ilex crenata</b>	Japanese Holly	<b>Slow growing, dense evergreen plants, great alternative to Buxus for a low hedge, hardy.</b>	\$8
	Helleri	Dwarf variety, full sun to partial shade, topiaries well, disease resistant, great low hedge. 40cm	
	Sky Pencil	Strict columnar shape, ideal for a formal entrance or for a focal point, easily maintained. 3m	
<b>Lonicera</b>		<b>Small shrubs that are excellent for hedging, dense, thick growth that trims easily, can be shaped.</b>	\$7
<b>nitida</b>	Box Honeysuckle	Dense, small foliated shrub. Ideal low hedge quicker growing than Buxus, trims well. 2m.	
<b>nitida rubra</b>	Honey Hedge Ruby	Dense, larger foliage. Purple red new growth in summer, striking hedge. 2m.	
<b>Myrtus ugni</b>	Chilean Guava	Small leafed tidy shrub with scented red edible fruit. Tidy trimmed hedge. 1.5m	\$7
<b>Olea europaea</b>	El Greco	Dense and bushy shrub that's well suited to hedging, screening & shaping, grey/green leaf. 4m	\$7
<b>Olearia</b>		<b>Hardy family of plants that handle wind, coastal conditions, can be used in riparian and hedgeline</b>	\$7
<b>albida</b>	Tanguru	Very hardy multi stemmed bush with leathery, olive green leaves, daisy like flowers. 6m.	
<b>albida x paniculata</b>	Large Leaf Paniculata	Tough wind hardy small trees, tree daisy family, scented flowers, handles damp soils. 5m.	
<b>nummularifolia</b>	Coin leaved Tree Daisy	Dense, twiggy growth, small yellow green leaves, tough alpine shrub, easily shaped hedges. 1.5m	
<b>paniculata</b>	Golden Ake Ake	Gold/green wavy foliage, flowers early autumn, wind hardy. 3m	
<b>Pittosporum</b>		<b>Small native trees with a variety of attractive leaf forms and colours.</b>	\$7
<b>eugenoides</b>	Tarata Lemonwood	Pale green/ gold wavy foliage, lemon scented leaves. 10m.	
<b>ralphii</b>	Ralphs Kohuhu	Rounded bushy habit & large, dark green leaves, white underside, red flowers, good for dry sites. 5m

<b>tenuifolium</b>	Limelight	Attractive variegated yellow-green foliage, sturdy bushy grower, excellent garden plant. 3m.	
<b>tenuifolium</b>	Mountain Green	Small, vibrant green leaves and a dense, compact, upright habit, great screening hedge. 4m	
<b>tenuifolium</b>	Tandara Gold	Erect pyramidal form with black branches and small gold splashed leaves, easily trshaped. 3m	
<b>Podocarpus totara</b>		<b>Family of trees that are widely grown and known for their robust shape and prickly foliage.</b>	<b>\$10</b>
	Totara	Iconic NZ tree, hardy, slow growing, prickly foliage. Grows well in wet areas. 30m.	
	Ardmore Green	Bright green larger leaf foliage. Beautiful hedge and specimen tree. 8m.	
	Matapouri Blue	Striking blue foliage, lovely as hedge or specimen. Upright pyramidal habit. 4m.	
<b>Pseudopanax</b>		<b>Excellent landscaping plants with strong, attractive leaf forms, texture and colour.</b>	<b>\$8</b>
<b>arboreus</b>	Five Finger	Large, deep green leaves of 5 serrated leaflets, small scented green flowers summer. 3m	
<b>crassifolium</b>	Lancewood	Long narrow juvenile foliage, older plants form a rounded head of smaller foliage. 4m.	
	Emerald Elf	Narrow bold green foliage on a small growing plant, prefers semi shade. 1.5m	
<b>ferox</b>		A spectacular slow growing specimen with saw tooth leaves. Hardy. 5m.	<b>\$10</b>
<b>laetus</b>	Taranaki Five Finger	Large glossy "fingers" foliage, subtropical look, bees enjoy the flowers. 4m.	
<b>lessonii</b>	Houpara	Multi branched plants that can grow leaves of 3 or 5. Colours in the green shades. 4m.	
<b>Quercus ilex</b>	Holm Oak	This broad spreading tree makes a lovely hedge when kept trimmed, very hardy. 15m	<b>\$8</b>
<b>Rosemarinus</b>		<b>Variety of herbal shrubs that can be used as hedging.</b>	<b>\$7</b>
<b>officinalus</b>	Pink Remembrance	Upright, green shrub with aromatic foliage with beautiful pink flowers Winter to Summer. 1m.	
<b>officinalus</b>	Tuscan Blue	Hardy edible herb, wonderful in an aromatic hedge, lovely blue flowers Winter to Summer. 1.2m	
<b>Teucrium fruiticans</b>	Silver Germander	Grey/green foliage, rapid growth, requires regular clipping, blue/mauve flowers. 1.5m	<b>\$7</b>
