	Beatsons Gold	Compact rounded shrubs with small variagated green/gold leaves, trims easily, very hardy. 1.2m+	
	Cappuccino	Bronze/brown leaves, which lighten to a coffee colour in Winter, smaller leaves than most repens. 1.2m	
	Middlemore	Fantastic coprosma for screening/hedging, small round glossy leaves, tight growth, hardy. 1mx2m	
	Portwine	Bronze/red foliage, excellent for hedging, glossy leaves and tight growth, hardy. 1.5m	
<b>robusta</b>	Karamu	Fast growing shelter, deging and nursery plant, competes well with gorse, attracts birds. 5m+	
<b>rugosa</b>	Lobster	Divaricating pyramidal shrub, bronze/green foliage, pink/gold trunks, cool looking plant. 1.2cm.

<b>truncata</b>	Tawhairaunui Hard Beech	Tall forest tree with small blunt toothed leaves, grows best in water logged areas. 30m+	
<b>Hedycarya arborea</b>	Porokaiwhiri Pigeonwood	An attractive tree, small but fragrant flowers, male and female separate trees, orange red berries. 6m+	<b>\$9</b>
<b>Knightia excelsa</b>	Rewarewa NZ Honeysuckle	Narrow, colunar form, long, very serrated leathery leaves, red flowers for the birds very hardy. 7m	<b>\$9</b>
<b>Lophozonia menziesii</b>	Silver Beech	Common forest canopy tree, silvery bark and rough edges small leathery leaves. 30m+	<b>\$9</b>

<b>nummularifolia</b>	Coin Leaved Tree Daisy	Hardy shrub, tight twiggy growth, chartruese small leaves, easily trimmed, can be used like Buxus. 1.2m	
<b>paniculata</b>	Golden Ake Ake	Gold/green wavy foliage, flowers early autumn, wind hardy. 3m	
<b>Phyllocladus trichomanoides</b>	Tanekaha Celery Pine	Tall tree with a pyramidal form, foliage is celery like in the adult and feathery in juvenile form. 12m+	<b>\$10</b>

<b>prostrata</b>	Dwarf Kowhai	Dense, tangled, wiry shrub with sparse foliage and hidden flowers in late Spring, semi-deciduous. 2m+	
<b>tetraptera</b>	North Island Kowhai	Larger leaves & flowers, golden, eastern dryer region, 5-12m.	
<b>Veronica</b>		<b>Formally Hebe. A variety of flowering shrubs, long panicles of flowers. Lizard/bird food.</b>	<b>\$7</b>

<b>buchanani</b>	Coastal Sedge	Reddish/brown, erect habit, curled tips of the blades. 60cm.	
<b>comans</b>	Bronze	Bronze, flowing, neat circular clump, comb out dead leaves to keep tidy. 40cm.	
<b>comans</b>	Frosted Curl	Light green/cream curled tips, flowing, neat and tidy habit. 40cm.
